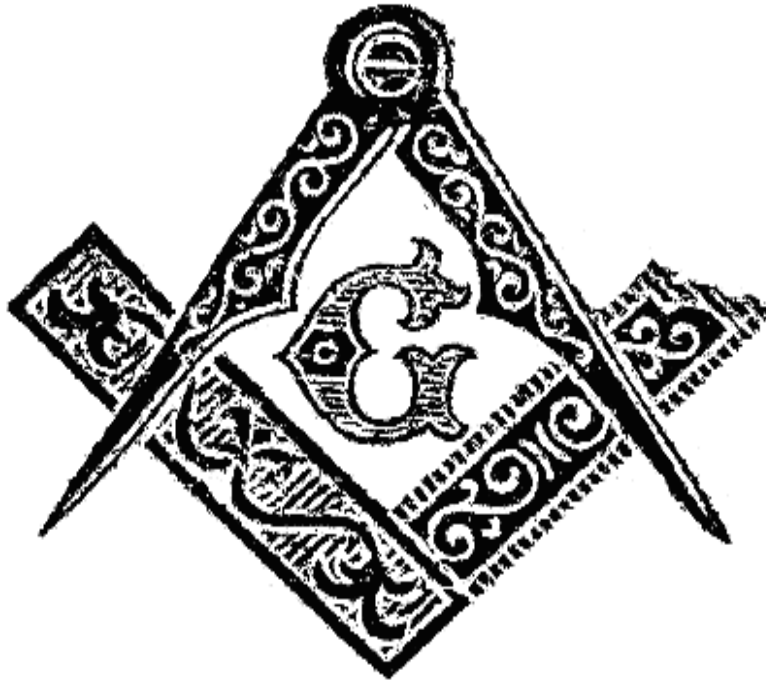

IN ENGLAND AND WALES, there is a long tradition of “affinity lodges,” where all the members (usually about 40) share a particular interest in addition to Masonry.

Freemasons in London, for example, often join lodges associated with their occupations, military units, and schools. They have names such as Bank of England, United Engineers, Society of Musicians, and Royal Navy.

Other lodges are centered on the legal profession, teaching, and the theatre; and recent lodges formed by tennis, sports car, and karate enthusiasts. In a similar vein, we have the Kane Lodge in New York which supports scientific discovery, General Knox Lodge in Boston for current and former members of the armed forces, and Justice Lodge in Kansas for police officers; and in Tampa and Miami, lodges of Cuban-Americans work in the Spanish language.

These special interest lodges offer interesting possibilities for the future of our Craft. May their numbers increase. Δ
