California Masons donate to Ukraine

THE GRAND LODGE OF CALIFORNIA, together with Prince Hall Masons in that state, recently gave \$76,000 to the International Red Cross to provide support for civilians in war-torn Ukraine.

Grand Master Jeffrey Wilkins said: "Charity and relief are cherished values of Freemasons everywhere, and as Masons, we are committed to helping those in need in all communities. This gift will provide important services for the Ukrainian people in their darkest hour."

Aid has also come from the Masonic Charitable Foundation in England, and from other Masonic groups in Europe and the United States.

Masonry in Eastern Europe has a long history, with the Grand Lodge of Ukraine currently overseeing 14 lodges. Ironically, Russian army officers formed the first lodge in Kiev in 1784. Δ
